Central Statistics Office seeks cooperation of citizens for key survey

The Central Statistics Office of St. Lucia is seeking the cooperation of the general public to ensure that vital information on the work force continues to be available. The Labour Force is an ongoing survey which has been conducted by the Central Statistics Office since 1994. The survey collects reliable and up to date information from all members of randomly selected households for a one week reference period.

The statistics office analyzes the information collected and releases information for various population sub-groups. The data allow the office to track unemployment by sex, age group, education level and average income and also assist governments, communities, businesses and organizations to make informed decisions about jobs and employment conditions.

All personal information provided to the Central Statistics Office remains strictly confidential. Stringent safeguards are in place. All field officers who collect data must take an oath of secrecy and display a picture identification card provided by the Central Statistics Office.

Members of households selected to participate and who wish to confirm the status of the survey may contact the Central Statistics Office.

Data currently being collected for the Labour Force survey will be published in (May, 2017).
