The Caribbean Telecommunications Union (CTU) has received a grant from the World Bank toward the cost of providing support to the **Caribbean Regional Communications Infrastructure Program (CARCIP) Project**, and intends to apply part of the proceeds for consulting services.

The consulting services (the Services) include the delivery of a website that consolidates the Client's web presence and re-engineers its online content management system, while promoting the CARCIP.

Eligible consulting firms (Consultants) are invited to indicate their interest in providing the Services demonstrating that they have the required qualifications and relevant experience to perform the Services. As such, Consultant's are asked to provide a copy of (i) certificate of incorporation and (ii) VAT registration certificate (where applicable). In addition, Consultants will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- (i) Core Business and Years in Business;
- (ii) Experience in field of assignment;
- (iii) Technical and managerial organization; and
- (iv) General qualifications and number of key staff.

The short list may comprise entirely of national consultants.

The attention of interested Consultants is drawn to paragraph 1.9 of the World Bank's [\*Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits and Grants by World Bank Borrowers\*](#) dated January 2011 ("Consultant Guidelines"), setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Consultants may associate with other firms in the form of a joint venture or a sub-consultancy to enhance their qualifications. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Selection based on Consultants' Qualifications (CQS) method set out in the Consultant Guidelines.
